Committee for Safe Schools

Be it resolved by the Hermon Town Council, in town council assembled, that a committee be established titled "Committee for Safe Schools". The committee will consist of 7 members that will include a member of the Town Council, a member of the School Board, two law enforcement officers, two parents and one school principle. The Town of Carmel will also be offered one position that can be served either by a Selectman or member of the School Board. The members of the committee will be appointed by the Town Council upon consultation with the Chairman of the School Board. The Town Manager and Superintendent of Schools will provide the administrative support for the Committee. All meetings will be subject to the provisions of the State of Maine Right to Know Law. Initial approval to establish the committee will expire on June 30, 2014. The Town Council will then reconsider the continuation of the committee on an annual basis.

Be it further resolved, that the purpose of the Committee will be to review the School's Safety and Security Policy to assure that recommendations provided by the Law Enforcement Committee have been implemented, to assure the provisions of the Hermon School Department Security Plan are implemented and followed, to recommend to the Hermon School Board changes to the policy as may be necessary, and to meet at least once each school year to receive any reports of incidents or concerns that have occurred that could jeopardize the safety and security of students and personnel, to conduct a site visit of all schools and to review the Safety and Security Plan. All recommendations will be submitted to the School Board and minutes of the meetings will be provided to the Town Council and School Board.
